THE ORGANISATION

Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) is a Pontifical Foundation dedicated to the persecuted and suffering Church. Founded by Fr Werenfried van Straaten O.Praem in 1947 as a Catholic aid organisation for war refugees, ACN is the only international Catholic organisation today that focuses on the pastoral and spiritual support of suffering Christians. Through the offerings of over 400,000 benefactors worldwide, ACN raises approximately AUD \$200 million each year for some 5000 projects in 140 countries. ACN Australia began in 1965 and is one of 23 national offices which seeks to raise awareness and financial support for this work.

THE ROLE

The role of the Diocesan Outreach Assistant is to share the work of Aid to the Church in Need across Australia through the delivery of ten parish presentations across the course of a year.

The primary tasks of the Diocesan Outreach Assistant are:

- To Raise awareness of the suffering and persecuted Church by sharing the stories of our brothers and sisters who suffer or are persecuted for their faith. The DOA will encourage parishioners to sign up to receive the ACN's Newsletter.
- To invite parishioners to pray for the persecuted and suffering Church.
- To inspire parishioners to take action to support the suffering Church and to join ACN in its journey to keep the faith alive.

Presentations will take place in parishes during the weekend Masses and the same presentation is repeated during all the weekend Masses in a particular parish. Following each Mass, the Diocesan Outreach Assistant sells book and religious items and encourages people to sign up for more information.

All Diocesan Outreach Assistants will be given formation and training around the mission of Aid to the Church in Need and the specifics of delivering parish presentations. Ongoing support will be provided.

The Diocesan Outreach Assistant is offered a stipend per weekend of presentations which involve talk preparation, stock ordering, data processing, liaising with parishes to arrange presentations, travel time and the delivery of the actual talk.

The Diocesan Outreach Assistant will be engaged for a twelve-month period in which they commit to deliver the presentations. Performance will be reviewed annually with the opportunity for a further twelve-month renewal.

KEY REQUIREMENTS

- A committed and active Catholic with a knowledge and understanding of their faith
- An understanding of the mission and work of Aid to the Church Need
- A good communicator and a confident public speaker
- Physically able to cope with travel and setting up the stall/information booth
- Confident in the general use of the internet, email, Word and Excel
- A current driver's licence and a willingness to travel within the designated area
- Friendly and respectful in manner
- Professional in approach
- Able to relate to people at all levels
- Happy to work under pressure
- Able to be work independently and be self-motivated
- All new appointments are subject to a satisfactory Police Check and Working with Children Check.
